

RESIDENTIAL WATER USE CHANGE

Based on the motion adopted by the Nashville Village Council on July 8, 1982 requiring any resident changing their occupational use of their building, according to Sewer Rate and Connection Ordinance #2-14-80, must sign a letter of intent stating the change in occupational use. If the change is made without notification to the Village the billing will not change until the Village is notified and an agreement is signed. Also according to the Zoning Ordinance effective February 18, 2012 any properties in the RA, RB, & CBD zoned areas will need a special use permit to change the occupational use of their building by creating a new or reinstate a past unused apartment in their building.

Therefore, I _____ based on the above information; wish to change the occupational use of my home at _____ Nashville from a double use building to a single use building effective _____. I understand this will eliminate my building from receiving multiple water base rates (\$13.50 per month), multiple sewer base rates (\$14.00 per month), multiple Sewer Improvement Fund Charge (\$4.00per month) and multiple Water Improvement Fund Charge (\$4.50 per month). The base rates per month will be for only one business use.
